# **H.Res. 180**

*2021 Session of the House of Commons*

## **An Resolution of the Assembly**

To allow the Speaker to veto a bill or resolution that passes before the House and the measures needed to override the veto.

*Be it enacted by the House of Commons assembled,*

**SECTION 1. VETO.**

- (a) The Speaker of the House of Commons may veto any resolution or bill that passes the House within seven (7) days of its passing in the House.
- (b) The Speaker must provide a reasoning for the veto.

**SECTION 2. VETO OVERRIDE.**

- (a) Any member may introduce a motion to override the veto once it has been vetoed.
- (b) The Chair must have the veto reasoning read aloud to members.
- (c) There will be no debate on the motion.
- (d) The House shall vote as it normally does in any motion and must pass with  $\frac{3}{4}$  in the affirmative to override the veto.
