Providing for consideration of the bill (HR 570) The Grass Restoration Act of 2021; Providing for consideration of the bill (HR 785), The 2021 Summer Vacation Act; Providing for consideration of the Resolution (H.Res. 1737) in the matter of Tim Cavinder; and for other purposes

SEC 1

That upon the adoption of the Resolution, it shall be in order to consider in the House the bill (HR 570) for The Grass Restoration Act of 2021. All points of order against consideration of the bill are waived. The amendment in the nature of a substitute recommended by the Committee on Natural Resources now printed in the bill shall be considered as adopted. The bill, as amended, shall be considered as read. All points of order against provisions in the bill, as amended, are waived. The previous question shall be considered as ordered on the bill, as amended, and on any further amendment thereto, to final passage without intervening motion except (1) one hour of debate equally dived and controlled by the Chair and Ranking Member of the Committee on Natural Resources or their respective designees; and (2) one motion to recommit

SEC 2

Upon adoption of this Resolution, it shall be in order to consider in the House in the bill (HR 785) for The 2021 Summer Vacation Act. All points of order against consideration of the bill are waived. The amendment in the nature of a substitute recommended by the Committee on Summer Vacation now printed in the bill shall be considered as adopted. The bill, as amended, shall be considered as read. All points of order against provisions in the bill, as amended, are waived. The previous question shall be considered as ordered on the bill, as amended, and on any further amendment thereto, to final passage without intervening motion except (1) one hour of debate equally dived and controlled by the Chair and Ranking Member of the Committee on Summer Vacation or their respective designees; and (2) one motion to recommit.

SEC 3

(a) Upon adoption of this Resolution, it shall be in order to consider in the House in the Resolution (H.Res. 1737) for in the matter of Tim Cavinder. All points of order against consideration of the Resolution are waived. The amendment in the nature of a substitute recommended by the Committee on Ethics now printed in the Resolution shall be considered as adopted. The Resolution, as amended, shall be

considered as read. All points of order against provisions in the bill, as amended, are waived. The previous question shall be considered as ordered on the Resolution, as amended, and on any further amendment thereto, to final passage without intervening motion except (1) one hour of debate equally divided and controlled by the Chair and Ranking Member of the Committee on Ethics or their respective designees; and (2) one motion to recommit.

(b) The representative Tim Cavinder is unable to vote on H.Res. 1737 under this adoption of this Resolution

SEC 4

House Resolution 188 is amended—

(a) in Section 1, by striking “April 16, 2021” and inserting “April 22, 2021”

(b) in Section 1, by striking “May 16, 2021” and inserting “May 22, 2021”

SEC 5

(a) At any time through the legislative day through May, 22, 2021, the Speaker may entertain motions offered by the Leader or a designee that the House suspend the rules with respect to multiple measures described in subsection (b), and the Chair shall put the question on any such motion without debate or intervening motion.

(b) A measure referred to subsection (a) includes any measure that was the object of a motion to suspend the rules on which the yeas and nays are ordered and further proceedings postponed

(c) Upon offering of a motion pursuant to subsection (a) concerning multiple measures, the ordering of the yeas and nays on postponed motions to suspend the rules with respect to such measures is vacated to end that all such motions are considered as withdrawn

SEC 6

(a) A member designee may do proxy voting when the member is not present. The member shall seek recognition from the Chair and announce the member's vote.

(b) Proxy voting does not apply to a quorum

SEC 7

(a) A recorded vote must occur if suspending the rules and $\frac{3}{4}$ must agree on suspension of the rules and passage
