RESOLUTION

TO

Providing for consideration of H.R. 2345 and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED by this House of Commons, in this present, assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows: —

1 *Resolved*, that upon adoption of this resolution it shall be in order to
2 consider in the House the bill (H.R. 2345) the house renovation act of 2021.
3 All points of order against consideration of the bill are waived. An
4 amendment in the nature of a substitute consisting of the text printed in the
5 bill, modified by the Committee on Finance, accompanying this resolution,
6 shall be considered as adopted. The bill, as amended, shall be considered as
7 read. All points of order against provisions in the bill, as amended, are
8 waived. The previous question shall be considered as ordered on the bill,
9 as amended, and on any further amendment thereto, to final passage
10 without intervening motion except: (1) one hour of debate equally divided
11 and controlled by the Chair and the Ranking Member of the Committee on
12 Finance or their respective designee; (2) the further amendments described
13 in section 2 of this resolution; (3) the amendments en bloc described in
14 section 3 of this resolution; and (4) one motion to recommit.

15 **SECTION 2.** After debate pursuant to the first section of this resolution,
16 each further amendment printed in part B of amendment paper 2102-12 not
17 earlier considered as part of amendments en bloc pursuant to section 3 of
18 this resolution shall be considered only in the order printed in the report,
19 may be offered only by a Member designed in the report, shall be
20 considered as read, shall be debatable for the time specified in the paper
21 equally divided and controlled by the proponent and an opponent, may be
22 withdrawn by the proponent at any time before the question is put thereon,

23 shall not be subject to amendment, and shall not be subject to a demand for
24 division of the question.

25 **SECTION 3.** It shall be in order at any time after debating pursuant to the
26 first section of the resolution for the chair of the Committee on Finance or
27 her designee to offer amendments en bloc consisting of further
28 amendments printed in part B of amendment paper 2102-12 accompanying
29 this resolution not earlier disposed of. Amendments en bloc offered
30 pursuant to this section shall be considered as read, shall be debatable for
31 30 minutes equally divided and controlled by the Chair and Ranking
32 Member of the Committee on Finance or their respective designee, shall not
33 be subject to amendment, and shall not be subject to a demand for division
34 of the question.

35 **SECTION 4.** All points of order against the further amendments printed in
36 the amendment paper 2102-12 or amendments en bloc described in section
37 3 of this resolution are waived.

38 **SECTION 5.** (a) At any time through the legislative day of August 31, 2021,
39 the Speaker may entertain motion offered by anyone that the House
40 suspend the rules as though under clause 1 of rule XV with respect to
41 multiple measures described in subsection (b), and the Chair shall put the
42 question on any such motion without debate or intervening motion.

43 (b) A measure referred to in subsection (a) includes any measure that was
44 the object of a motion to suspend the rules on the legislative day of August
45 1, 2021 through August 31, 2021, in the form as so offered, on which the
46 yeas and nays were ordered and further proceedings postponed pursuant
47 to section 4(e)(1) of House Resolution 1.

48 (c) Upon offering of motion pursuant to subsection (a) concerning multiple
49 measures, the ordering of the yeas and nays on postponed motions to
50 suspend the rules with respect to such measures is vacated to the end that
51 all such motions are considered as withdrawn.

52 **SECTION 6.** Notwithstanding section 4(e)(1) of House Resolution 1,
53 further proceedings on a vote by the yeas and nays on the question of
54 adoption of a motion that the House suspend the rules offered of any

55 legislative day from August 1, 2021 through August 31, 2021, may continue
56 to be postponed through the legislative day of September 22, 2021.

57 **SECTION 7.** Without objection, the Journal of Proceedings are agreed to.
