# JOINT RESOLUTION

TO

have the House stand in Recess for Tennessee Vacation, and for Mask Requirements, and for Other Purposes

**B**E IT ENACTED by this House of Commons, in this present, assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows: —

1 **SECTION 1. RECESS.**

2 (a) Following all the Business before the House on October 16, 2021,  
3 the House shall stand adjourned in recess until October 26, 2021.

4 (b) Notwithstanding Clause 1(c) of Rule 19, all postponed  
5 proceedings shall resume on October 26, 2021.

6 **SECTION 2. MASK REQUIREMENTS.**

7 **FINDINGS—**

8 (a) The House, assembled, finds that while COVID-19 cases are  
9 decreasing across the Country;

10 (b) It still remains critical that masks remain a tool to prevent  
11 the spread of COVID-19;

12 (c) Health experts across the world agree that masks are still  
13 needed to keep you and other safe during this pandemic.

14           **RESOLVED –**

15                   (a) During the Vacation and adjournment of this House, masks  
16                   shall be required at all feasible times except while:

17                           (i) In the Cabin

18                           (ii) In the National Park (outside)

19                           (iii) Actively eating
