to

providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 8752), The
Cabinet Act and further amendments to the respective
bill.

BE IT ENACTED by this House of Commons, in this present, assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

- 1 RESOLVED, that upon adoption of this resolution it shall
2 be in order to consider in the House the bill (H.R. 8752)
3 The Cabinet Act. All points of order against consideration
4 of the bill are waived. The bill shall be considered as read.
5 All points of order against provisions in the bill are
6 waived. The previous question shall be considered as
7 ordered on the bill and on any further amendment
8 thereto, to final passage without intervening motion
9 except: (1) one hour of debate equally divided and
10 controlled by the chair and ranking member of the
11 Committee on Rules & Reform or their respective
12 designees; (2) the further amendments described in
13 section 2 of this resolution; (3) the amendments en bloc
14 described in section 3 of this resolution; and (4) one
15 motion to recommit.
- 16 SECTION 2. After debate pursuant to the first section of
17 this resolution, each further amendment printed in part B
18 of the report of the Committee on Rules & Reform not
19 earlier considered as part of amendments en bloc
20 pursuant to section 3 of this resolution shall be considered
21 only in the order printed in the report, may be offered
22 only by a Member designated in the report, shall be
23 considered as read, shall be debatable for the time
24 specified in the report equally divided and controlled by
25 the proponent and an opponent, may be withdrawn by the
26 proponent at any time before the question is put thereon,
27 shall not be subject to amendment, and shall not be
28 subject to a demand for division of the question.
- 29 SECTION 3. It shall be in order at any time after debate
30 pursuant to the first section of this resolution for the chair

31 of the Committee on Rules & Reform or his designee to
32 offer amendments en bloc consisting of further
33 amendments printed in part B of the report of the
34 Committee on Rules & Reform accompanying this
35 resolution not earlier disposed of. Amendments en bloc
36 offered pursuant to this section shall be considered as
37 read, shall be debatable for 20 minutes equally divided
38 and controlled by the chair and ranking member of the
39 Committee on Rules & Reform or their respective
40 designees, shall not be subject to amendment, and shall
41 not be subject to a demand for division of the question.

42 SECTION 4. All points of order against the further
43 amendments printed in part B of the report of the
44 Committee on Rules & Reform or amendments en bloc
45 described in section 3 of this resolution are waived.
