- 9 except: (1) one hour of debate equally divided and
- 10 controlled by the chair and ranking member of the
- 11 Committee on Rules & Reform or their respective
- designees; (2) the further amendments described in
- section 2 of this resolution; (3) the amendments en bloc
- described in section 3 of this resolution; and (4) one
- 15 motion to recommit.
- 16 SECTION 2. After debate pursuant to the first section of
- this resolution, each further amendment printed in part B
- of the report of the Committee on Rules & Reform not
- 19 earlier considered as part of amendments en bloc
- 20 pursuant to section 3 of this resolution shall be considered
- 21 only in the order printed in the report, may be offered
- only by a Member designated in the report, shall be
- 23 considered as read, shall be debatable for the time
- 24 specified in the report equally divided and controlled by
- 25 the proponent and an opponent, may be withdrawn by the
- 26 proponent at any time before the question is put thereon,
- shall not be subject to amendment, and shall not be
- subject to a demand for division of the question.
- 29 SECTION 3. It shall be in order at any time after debate
- 30 pursuant to the first section of this resolution for the chair

- of the Committee on Rules & Reform or his designee to 31
- offer amendments en bloc consisting of further 32
- amendments printed in part B of the report of the 33
- Committee on Rules & Reform accompanying this 34
- resolution not earlier disposed of. Amendments en bloc 35
- offered pursuant to this section shall be considered as 36
- 37 read, shall be debatable for 20 minutes equally divided
- and controlled by the chair and ranking member of the 38
- Committee on Rules & Reform or their respective 39
- designees, shall not be subject to amendment, and shall 40
- not be subject to a demand for division of the question. 41
