**B**E IT ENACTED by this House of Commons, in this present, assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1 RESOLVED, That upon adoption of this resolution it  
2 shall be in order to consider in the House the resolution  
3 (H. Res. 872) to permit the Speaker of the House to assign  
4 districts. All points of order against consideration of the  
5 resolution are waived. The resolution shall be considered  
6 as read. All points of order against provisions in the  
7 resolution are waived. The previous question shall be  
8 considered as ordered on the resolution and on any  
9 further amendment thereto, to final passage without  
10 intervening motion except: (1) one hour of debate equally  
11 divided and controlled by the chair and ranking member  
12 of the Committee on Rules and Reform or their respective  
13 designees; and (2) one motion to recommit.

14 RESOLVED, That upon adoption of this resolution it  
15 shall be in order to consider in the House the bill (H.R.  
16 7420) to repeal Chapter 2 of Title 1 and replace this Act to  
17 amend the Summer Vacation Planning Act of 2021. All  
18 points of order against consideration of the bill are  
19 waived. The bill shall be considered as read. All points of  
20 order against provisions in the bill are waived. The  
21 previous question shall be considered as ordered on the  
22 resolution and on any further amendment thereto, to final  
23 passage without intervening motion except: (1) one hour  
24 of debate equally divided and controlled by the chair and  
25 ranking member of the Committee on Summer Vacation  
26 or their respective designees; and (2) one motion to  
27 recommit.

28 RESOLVED, that H. Res. 1 is amended by striking all  
29 dates in Section 4 and replacing it with “December 31,  
30 2021”.
