Be it enacted by the House of Commons assembled,

SECTION 1001. Summer vacation report.

(a) The Committee on Summer Vacations files a Committee Report that the bill do pass, amended.

SECTION 1002. Rules and reform report.

(a) The Committee on Rules and Reform files a Committee Report on the rule.

Subsection B – VARIOUS MICHIGAN LOCATIONS SECTION 2001. Notice.

(a) This Act shall be in addition to HR 785, the 2021 Summer Vacation Act.

SECTION 2002. Location

- (a) Michigan Adventures
- (b) Sawyer, MI
- (c) Great Wolf Lodge

SECTION 2004. Dates.

(a) The locations listed in this Act with addition to HR 785 shall occur within the timeframe permitted in HR 785.

SECTION 2005. Authority.

(a) The Chair of the Committee on Summer Vacation shall have the authority on dates to book and has the duty to inform the House of Commons as a whole on specifics within appropriate notice.
