certain pupils paycheck goes towards House funding.

TABLE OF PROVISIONS.

SECTION 1.	TITLE.

BE IT ENACTED by this House of Commons, in this present, assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1 **SECTION 1. Title.**

2 (a) This Act may be called, “The House Tax Code of 2021”.

3 **SECTION 2. Authority.**

4 (a) This Act shall give the authority to tax individuals in
5 order to maintain programs offered by the House.

6 **SECTION 3. Pupils subjected.**

7 (a) The Speaker has the authority to decide who is
8 subjected to taxation.

9 **SECTION 4. Percentage.**

10 (a) The House shall have the authority to tax up to 15%
11 on every \$1,000 of income on subjected pupils if the pupil
12 filing monthly or makes less than \$10,000 in one year.

13 (b) If a pupil makes more than \$10,000 in one year, the
14 House has the authority to tax up to 11% on the total
15 income only.

16 **SECTION 5. Failure of taxation.**

17 (a) Members who fail to file monthly or yearly may
18 request an extension through the Clerk of the House.

19 (b) If an extension is not filed, the member is subject to
20 punishment by the House through:

21 (i) Censure

22 (ii) Voting Privilege Revoked

23 (iii) Disqualification of House Services

24 **SECTION 6. Filing.**

25 (a) Members can file monthly, which is due on 28th day
26 each month.

27 (b) Members can file yearly, which is due on December
28 30th of the year.
