Amend Title 3, Section 4, of House of Commons Code to Pub. L. 212-01 – The House Renovation Act of 2021.

BE IT ENACTED by this House of Commons, in this present, assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows: –

1 **SECTION 1. Title.**

2 (a) This Act may be called “Amending Title 3, Section 4 of House of
3 Commons Code”.

4 **SECTION 2. Amendment.**

5 *Following subsection (a) of Section 4, insert the following:*

6 (b) Damages – Any damage to the House itself or its subsequent
7 property by anyone under the enactment of this Act is subject to one
8 of the following:

9 (a) Filing of an Insurance Claim with the insurer signed by the
10 Speaker of the House

11 (b) Lawsuit filled and signed by the Clerk and Speaker of the
12 House against the individual(s) involved

13 (c) subsection (b) shall be in compliance with 3 H.C.C. § 24(b) (2021)
14 with all necessary decelerations

15 (i) Subsection (a) shall be classified under “damage” as defined
16 under 3 H.C.C. § 25(b) (2021)

17 (ii) 3 H.C.C. § 24(c) (2021) shall not apply to this Act
