- 4 SECTION 2. Amendment.
- 5 Following subsection (a) of Section 4, insert the following:
- (b) Damages Any damage to the House itself or its subsequent
 property by anyone under the enactment of this Act is subject to one
 of the following:
 - (a) Filling of an Insurance Claim with the insurer signed by the Speaker of the House
 - (b) Lawsuit filled and signed by the Clerk and Speaker of the House against the individual(s) involved
- 13 (c) subsection (b) shall be in compliance with 3 H.C.C. § 24(b) (2021) 14 with all necessary decelerations
- (i) Subsection (a) shall be classified under "damage" as defined under 3 H.C.C. § 25(b) (2021)
- 17 (ii) 3 H.C.C. § 24(c) (2021) shall not apply to this Act
