Be it enacted by the House of Commons assembled,

SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

This Act may be cited as “The Dinner Act”.

TITLE I – COMMITTEE ON AGRICULTURE

Subsection A – Reports

SECTION 1001. Committee report.

(a) There is no Committee report from the Committee.

Subsection B – Dinner Decisions

SECTION 1002. Dinner decision.

(a) The Chair of the Committee on Agriculture shall decide what will be Dinner for the House within a reasonable timeframe.

(b) The Chair may appoint a designee to make the necessary decision.

(c) If the Chair or the Chair's designee cannot make a decision, the Speaker shall bring the House into session pursuant to House Resolution 188, Section 1(c).

(a) The Speaker shall entertain motions on what is dinner and must pass pursuant to House Resolution 188 rules.
