

H.R. 673 – Summer Vacation Planning Act

SEC 1001 – Hearing

Members shall submit locations for vacation.

The Committee shall have hearing for five (5) minutes of each location submitted ask if there are any locations that have unanimous consent to be removed.

The Committee shall have two (2) days to process the information before SEC 1002 takes affect.

SEC 1002 – Committee Vote

The Chair and Ranking Member shall vote on any remaining locations.

If both members are in favor, the location shall move to the House for final passage.

If both members are against, the location shall not be considered.

If the Chair and Ranking Member are in disagreement, the location must be pulled out of Committee by asking the House if the location shall be considered. If the motion passes, it shall move to final passage. If the motion fails, it shall not be considered.

SEC 1003 – House Vote

ENROLLED

Any remaining locations shall a final passage vote if they should be considered for vacation.

If the motion passes, the location is approved.

If the motion fails, the motion does not pass.

If multiple locations pass in the House, all passed locations must occur in the summer year, unless a motion is given and passes to remove a location for consideration due to multiple passing passages.

SEC 1004 – Argument Purposes

Any natural disaster or health and safety matters possibility and/or threat in any location shall not be an argument for not going to a particular location.

SEC 1005 – Overruling

The Chair of the Committee on Summer Vacation shall have the right to overrule the decision of the House.

SEC 1006 – House Debate

No location shall exceed sixty (60) minutes of total debate.
