22	does not have the authority to strike House of
23	Commons Code or House Administrative Code
24	statutes as unconstitutional, but may suggest in
25	their opinion that a statute may be and ask the
26	House of Commons Assembly to correct it.
27	(d) AGENCY REPORTING VIOLATIONS.—Should
28	an Agency believe that a Member has violated a
29	statute or an Administrative Code that is within
30	the Agency's jurisdiction, it shall report the
31	suspected violation to the Sergeant-at-Arms who
32	shall determine if they will file a criminal
33	complaint against the Member, notwithstanding
34	HCC § 2-2-6(b)(1)."

37	"(1) AUTHORITY TO ISSUE.—Authorized persons
38	as described in HCC § 2-2-6(b)(3) shall have the
