E IT ENACTED by this House of Commons with the advice and consent of the same, as follows:

- 1 Whereas, brushing teeth is a critical part of a person's
- 2 overall heath.
- 3 Whereas, not brushing teeth is linked to serious health
- 4 issues, like gingivitis.
- 5 Whereas, regular dentist appointments are necessary to 6 ensure this continual proper oral care.
- 7 *Resolved*, that the House finds that brushing teeth two
- 8 times a day for two minutes is necessary to ensure proper
- 9 oral care.
- 10 Be it further, *Resolved*, that rinsing immediately after
- 11 brushing, including mouthwash, dilutes its effects and
- 12 washes away remaining fluoride.
