Provide for consideration of HR 10, The Privacy Act of  
2023.

## TABLE OF PROVISIONS.

SECTION 1. RESOLVED.

**B** **E IT ENACTED** *by this House of Commons with the advice and consent of the same, as follows:*

1 *Resolved*, that at any time after adoption of this  
2 resolution the Speaker may declare the House resolved  
3 into the Committee of the Whole House for consideration  
4 of the bill (HR 10) The Privacy Act of 2023. The first  
5 reading of the bill shall be dispensed with. All points of  
6 order against consideration of the bill are waived. General  
7 debate shall be confined to the bill and amendments  
8 specified in this section and shall not exceed one hour.  
9 After general debate, the bill shall be considered for  
10 amendment under the five-minute rule. The bill, as  
11 amended by the Committee on Natural Resources, shall  
12 be considered as the original bill for the purpose of further  
13 amendment under the five-minute rule. All points of order  
14 against provisions in the bill, as amended, are waived. No  
15 further amendments to the bill, as amended, shall be in  
16 order except those printed in Part B of the report of the  
17 Committee on Rules & Reform. Each such further  
18 amendment may be offered only in the order printed in  
19 the report, may be offered only by a Member designated  
20 in the report, shall be considered as read, shall not be  
21 subject to demand for division of the question in the  
22 House or in the Committee of the Whole House. All points  
23 of order against such further amendments are waived. At  
24 the conclusion of consideration of the bill for amendment  
25 the Committee shall rise and report the bill, as amended,

26 to the House with such further amendments as may have  
27 been adopted. The previous question shall be considered  
28 as ordered on the bill, as amended, and on any further  
29 amendment thereto to final passage without intervening  
30 motion except one motion to recommit.
