5 shall be considered as read. All points of order against
6 provisions in the measure shall be waived. The previous
7 question shall be considered as ordered thereto final
8 passage without intervening motion except: (1) one hour
9 of debate; and (2) one motion to recommit.

10 *Resolved*, that upon the adoption of this resolution it
11 shall be in order to consider in the House HR 19,
12 Monetary Relief Process Act. All points of order against
13 consideration of the measure are waived. The measure
14 shall be considered as read. All points of order against
15 provisions in the measure shall be waived. The previous
16 question shall be considered as ordered thereto final
17 passage without intervening motion except: (1) one hour
18 of debate; and (2) one motion to recommit.

19 *Resolved*, that upon the adoption of this resolution it
20 shall be in order to consider in the House HR 22,
21 Electronic Access to Taxes (EATA). All points of order
22 against consideration of the measure are waived. The
23 measure shall be considered as read. All points of order

24 against provisions in the measure shall be waived. The
25 previous question shall be considered as ordered thereto
26 final passage without intervening motion except: (1) one
27 hour of debate; and (2) one motion to recommit.
