statues related to positions, H. Res. 44, amending Rule  
XIX of the Rules of the House, H. J. Res. 10, providing for  
an amendment to the Constitution of the House, HR 24,  
Tax Fairness and Boost Act, and HR 25, Complaint  
Amendment Act of 2023.

**B** **E IT ENACTED** *by this House of Commons with the advice and consent of the same, as follows:*

1 *Resolved*, that upon the adoption of this resolution it  
2 shall be in order to consider in the House H. J. Res. 9,  
3 amending House statues related to positions. All points of  
4 order against consideration of the measure are waived.  
5 The measure shall be considered as read. All points of  
6 order against provisions in the measure shall be waived.  
7 The previous question shall be considered as ordered  
8 thereto final passage without intervening motion except:  
9 (1) one hour of debate; and (2) one motion to recommit.

10 *Resolved*, that upon the adoption of this resolution it  
11 shall be in order to consider in the House H. Res. 44,  
12 providing for an amendment to Rule XIX of the Rules of  
13 the House. All points of order against consideration of the  
14 measure are waived. The measure shall be considered as  
15 read. All points of order against provisions in the measure  
16 shall be waived. The previous question shall be considered  
17 as ordered thereto final passage without intervening  
18 motion except: (1) one hour of debate; and (2) one motion  
19 to recommit.

20 *Resolved*, that upon the adoption of this resolution it  
21 shall be in order to consider in the House H. J. Res. 10,  
22 providing for a proposed amendment to the Constitution

23 of the House. All points of order against consideration of  
24 the measure are waived. The measure shall be considered  
25 as read. All points of order against provisions in the  
26 measure shall be waived. The previous question shall be  
27 considered as ordered thereto final passage without  
28 intervening motion except: (1) one hour of debate; and (2)  
29 one motion to recommit.

30 *Resolved*, that upon the adoption of this resolution it  
31 shall be in order to consider in the House HR 25, the  
32 Complaint Amendment Act of 2023. All points of order  
33 against consideration of the measure are waived. The  
34 measure shall be considered as read. All points of order  
35 against provisions in the measure shall be waived. The  
36 previous question shall be considered as ordered thereto  
37 final passage without intervening motion except: (1) one  
38 hour of debate; and (2) one motion to recommit.

39 Resolved, that at any time after adoption of this  
40 resolution the Speaker may declare the House resolved  
41 into the Committee of the Whole House for consideration  
42 of the bill, HR 24, the Tax Fairness and Boost Act. The  
43 first reading of the bill shall be dispensed with. All points  
44 of order against consideration of the bill are waived.  
45 General debate shall be confined to the bill and shall not  
46 exceed one hour of debate. After general debate, the bill  
47 shall be considered for amendment under the five-minute  
48 rule. Amendments shall be in writing when being called  
49 up by Members. When the committee rises and reports  
50 the bill back to the house with a recommendation that  
51 said bill do pass, the previous question shall be considered

52 as order on the bill and amendments thereto to final  
53 passage without intervening motion except one motion to  
54 recommit.
