E IT ENACTED by this House of Commons with the advice and consent of the same, as follows:

- 4 SECTION 2. House finding.
- 5 The House of Commons finds that terrorism cannot be
- 6 tolerated and to that end, the House should do all in its
- 7 power to support victims.
- 8 SECTION 3. Tax amendment.
- 9 HCC § 2-11-5 is amended by adding:
- "(c) A Member who is taxed under subsection (a)
- shall be taxed at 12% of the amount calculated in
- employment tax for their 2023 fiscal year taxes for
- the purposes of supporting victims of terrorism."
