A BILL TO

Address the use of cameras on House property.

TABLE OF PROVISIONS.

SECTION 1.	TITLE.
SECTION 2.	ILLEGAL USE.
SECTION 3.	LAWFUL USES.
SECTION 4.	GOOD CAUSE EXEMPTIONS.

BE IT ENACTED *by this House of Commons with the advice and consent of the same, as follows:*

1 **SECTION 1. Title.**

2 This Act may be cited as “The Privacy Camera Act.”

3 **SECTION 2. Illegal use.**

4 It shall be unlawful for any person to install a camera for
5 the purposes of spying on an individual’s activity.

6 **SECTION 3. Lawful uses.**

7 The Highway Management Agency, as defined in HCC §
8 10-3-1(a), shall install cameras to:

9 (1) monitor the roads of the House; and to

10 (2) monitor outside activity that remains on the
11 property of the House.

12 **SECTION 4. Good cause exemptions.**

13 A Member may introduce a Resolution to permit camera
14 usage outside of the scope as described in this Act if it is
15 in the best interest of the House.

16 (1) APPROVAL.—The Resolution shall be a
17 recorded vote, and require approval of three-fourths
18 of the House.

19 (2) DESCRIPTIVE.—The Resolution must be exact
20 in:

21 (A) how long the exemption will last;

22 (B) how many camera(s) will be installed;

23 (C) where the camera(s) will be installed;

24 and

25 (D) the intention and purpose for installing
26 the camera(s).

Speaker of the House Assent
