A BILL TO

Establish monetary relief collection procedures.

TABLE OF PROVISIONS.

SECTION 1. TITLE.
SECTION 2. PAYMENT OF MONETARY RELIEF.

BE IT ENACTED *by this House of Commons with the advice and consent of the same, as follows:*

1 **SECTION 1. Title.**

2 This Act may be cited as “Monetary Relief Process Act.”

3 **SECTION 2. Payment of monetary relief.**

4 (a) CIVIL COMPLAINT.—Should the Inspector General
5 award monetary relief to a party, that money should be
6 collected in accordance with HCC § 2-1-6 and DOR shall
7 pay all parties that are awarded the monetary relief
8 within a reasonable amount of time after collection.

9 (b) CRIMINAL COMPLAINT.—Should the Inspector
10 General award monetary relief to the Speaker or
11 Sergeant-at-Arms, acting on behalf of the House of
12 Commons, shall collect monetary relief in accordance with
13 HCC § 2-1-6 and the money shall be the property of DOR.

14 (c) ADMINISTRATIVE COMPLAINT.—Should the
15 Inspector General award monetary relief to a party, that
16 money should be collected in accordance with HCC § 2-1-6
17 and DOR shall pay all parties that are awarded the
18 monetary relief within a reasonable amount of time after
19 collection.

- 20 (d) Monetary relief granted to the House of Commons
21 shall become the property of DOR.
