Establish seals for the House of Commons.

TABLE OF PROVISIONS.

SECTION 1. TITLE.
SECTION 2. SEALS.

BE IT ENACTED *by this House of Commons with the advice and consent of the same, as follows:*

1 **SECTION 1. Title.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “House Seals Act.”

3 **SECTION 2. Seals.**

4 (a) HOUSE OF COMMONS.—There shall be a seal of the
5 House of Commons, which shall include:

6 (1) 4 stars, each one to represent a Member of the
7 House;

8 (2) A Eagle; and

9 (3) The words:

10 (A) “House of Commons;”

11 (B) “Domus Divisa Poetri Stare;” and

12 (C) “MMIV.”

13 (b) HOUSE SPEAKER.—There shall be a seal for The
14 Speaker of the House of Commons which shall include:

15 (1) 4 Stars, each one to represent a Member of the
16 House;

17 (2) A Eagle;

18 (3) A Torch; and

19 (4) The words:

20 (A) “Speaker of the House;”

- 21 (B) “House of Commons;”
22 (C) “EST 2021;” and
23 (D) “Uniti Stamus Divisi Summus.”
- 24 (c) AGENCY SEALS.—Agencies shall create a seal which
25 shall, at a minimum, include:
- 26 (1) 4 Stars, each one to represent a Member of the
27 House;
28 (2) The words “House of Commons;” and
29 (3) The name of the Agency.
