## TABLE OF PROVISIONS.

SECTION 1. TITLE. SECTION 2. ACCESS.

E IT ENACTED by this House of Commons with the advice and consent of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Title.
- 2 This Act may be cited as the "Electronic Access to Taxes
- 3 Act of 2023 (EATA)."
- 4 SECTION 2. Access.
- 5 (a) GENERAL RIGHT.—Members of the House shall have
- 6 the right to access records electronically relating to the
- 7 respective:
- 8 (1) amount of money they owe;
- 9 (2) amount of money that has been paid; and
- 10 (3) their tax documentation.
- 11 (b) UNLAWFUL ACCESS.—It shall be unlawful for
- 12 anyone to access another Member's records and shall be a
- 13 Class A Misdemeanor.
- 14 (c) MANAGEMENT.—The Department of Revenue shall
- 15 manage all electronic record access with House agencies
- 16 reporting all monetary transactions to the Department of
- 17 Revenue.
