Allow electronic access to taxes.

TABLE OF PROVISIONS.

SECTION 1. TITLE.
SECTION 2. ACCESS.

B **E IT ENACTED** *by this House of Commons with the advice and consent of the same, as follows:*

1 **SECTION 1. Title.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Electronic Access to Taxes
3 Act of 2023 (EATA).”

4 **SECTION 2. Access.**

5 (a) GENERAL RIGHT.—Members of the House shall have
6 the right to access records electronically relating to the
7 respective:

8 (1) amount of money they owe;

9 (2) amount of money that has been paid; and

10 (3) their tax documentation.

11 (b) UNLAWFUL ACCESS.—It shall be unlawful for
12 anyone to access another Member’s records and shall be a
13 Class A Misdemeanor.

14 (c) MANAGEMENT.—The Department of Revenue shall
15 manage all electronic record access with House agencies
16 reporting all monetary transactions to the Department of
17 Revenue.
