- 5 The Inspector General shall have the authority to establish
- 6 rules of conduct for hearings, including establishing criteria to
- 7 grant or deny certain motions, which shall be published and
- 8 subject to House Administrative Code rules.
- 9 SECTION 3. Default judgement.
- 10 Amend HCC § 2-2-10(b) by striking "shall issue a decision
- 11 within ten (10) days from the motion" and insert "shall
- determine if a hearing is needed to determine that the party
- 13 willing refused to respond to the complaint, and upon the
- 14 conclusion of the hearing, or if was not deemed necessary, shall
- issue a decision within ten (10) days."
