**A BILL TO**

Amend the Due Process Act by establishing rules of  
conduct and default judgement.

---

**B** **E IT ENACTED** *by this House of Commons with the advice and consent of the same, as follows:*

1 **SECTION 1. Title.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Complaint Amendment Act of  
3 2023.”

4 **SECTION 2. Rules of conduct.**

5 The Inspector General shall have the authority to establish  
6 rules of conduct for hearings, including establishing criteria to  
7 grant or deny certain motions, which shall be published and  
8 subject to House Administrative Code rules.

9 **SECTION 3. Default judgement.**

10 Amend HCC § 2-2-10(b) by striking “shall issue a decision  
11 within ten (10) days from the motion” and insert “shall  
12 determine if a hearing is needed to determine that the party  
13 willing refused to respond to the complaint, and upon the  
14 conclusion of the hearing, or if was not deemed necessary, shall  
15 issue a decision within ten (10) days.”
