- 1 SECTION 1. Title.
- 2 This Act shall be cited as the "Marijuana Prohibition Act."

- 4 (a) It shall be unlawful for any person to possess or sell
- 5 any product, raw or in a product, that contains Hemp,
- 6 CBD, THC, or pure marijuana.
- 7 (b) Any person in violation shall have committed a Class
- 8 B Felony.
- 9 SECTION 3. Right of seizure.
- 10 The Speaker or the Inspector of the Office of the Inspector
- 11 General shall have the right to seize and destroy any
- 12 product in violation of § 2 of this Act.
