**A BILL TO**

Determine who is a feline, their respective rights, and  
establishing a violation of their rights as a misdemeanor.

**B** **E IT ENACTED** *by this House of Commons with the advice and consent of the same, as follows:*

1 **SECTION 1. Title.**

2 This Act may be cited as “The Feline Rights Act (TFRA)”

3 **SECTION 2. Felines.**

4 The following felines shall be subject to the guarantee of  
5 their rights as described in § 3 of this Act:

- 6 (1) Tux Cavinder;
- 7 (2) Ellie-Willow Cavinder; and
- 8 (3) McKenzie Cavinder.

9 **SECTION 3. Rights.**

10 All felines as described in § 2 of this Act shall have the  
11 following rights, not to be violated:

- 12 (1) The right to have kibble;
- 13 (2) The right to have fresh water; and
- 14 (3) The right to sit where they please without  
15 interference.

16 **SECTION 4. Violation of rights.**

17 Any Member who violates the right of a feline in § 3 shall  
18 have committed a Class D Misdemeanor.
