E IT ENACTED by this House of Commons with the advice and consent of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Title.
- 2 This Act may be cited as "The Disclosure Reporting Act
- 3 (TDRA)."
- 4 SECTION 2. Subject to reporting.
- 5 All Members of House shall be obligated to report the
- 6 following to the House:
- 7 (1) The purchase of a stock, mutual fund, or bond;
- 8 (2) The sale of a stock, mutual fund, or bond; and
- 9 (3) A donation made to a person running for public
- office, a cause, a college or university, or a political
- 11 party.
- 12 **SECTION 3. When to report.**
- 13 Members shall report within ten (10) days from the date
- of donation, purchase, or sale. Failure to report shall be
- 15 considered a Class C Misdemeanor.
- 16 SECTION 4. Management of reporting submissions.
- 17 (a) GENERAL MANAGEMENT.—The Clerk shall be
- authorized to take necessary action in order to collect
- 19 reports from Members.
- 20 (b) DATABASE.—The Clerk shall maintain a public
- 21 database that shall list:
- 22 (1) The Members Name;
