## A BILL TO

Require Members to report when the purchase or sell a stock, or donate money to certain persons and organizations, makes failing to report a Class C Misdemeanor, and providing for general management clauses.

---

**B** **E IT ENACTED** *by this House of Commons with the advice and consent of the same, as follows:*

1 **SECTION 1. Title.**

2 This Act may be cited as “The Disclosure Reporting Act  
3 (TDRA).”

4 **SECTION 2. Subject to reporting.**

5 All Members of House shall be obligated to report the  
6 following to the House:

- 7 (1) The purchase of a stock, mutual fund, or bond;
- 8 (2) The sale of a stock, mutual fund, or bond; and
- 9 (3) A donation made to a person running for public  
10 office, a cause, a college or university, or a political  
11 party.

12 **SECTION 3. When to report.**

13 Members shall report within ten (10) days from the date  
14 of donation, purchase, or sale. Failure to report shall be  
15 considered a Class C Misdemeanor.

16 **SECTION 4. Management of reporting submissions.**

17 (a) GENERAL MANAGEMENT.—The Clerk shall be  
18 authorized to take necessary action in order to collect  
19 reports from Members.

20 (b) DATABASE.—The Clerk shall maintain a public  
21 database that shall list:

- 22 (1) The Members Name;

- 23           (2) The Type of Report (Purchase, Sale, or  
24           Donation);  
25           (3) Date of Action; and  
26           (4) Date Reported.
