A BILL TO

Provide funding and action to reduce the level of radon in the House.

EIT ENACTED by this House of Commons with the advice and consent of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Title.

- 2 This bill may be cited as the "Safe Air and Radon
- 3 Mitigation Act of 2024 (SARMA)."
- 4 SECTION 2. Findings.
- 5 (a) Radon is a natural, odorless, colorless gas in nature.
- 6 Radon can enter homes and levels above 4 pCi/L,
- 7 according to the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA),
- 8 can pose a risk of lung cancer with lifetime exposure.
- 9 (b) On January 3, 2024, the House reported that the
- 10 radon level in the House was 9.4 pCi/L, above the EPA
- 11 limit.
- 12 **SECTION 3. Funding.**
- 13 The House may spend up to \$2,000 for the purposes of
- 14 enacting § 4 of this Act.
- 15 **SECTION 4. Action.**
- 16 (a) The Speaker shall appoint a Member of the House to
- 17 find a contractor to mitigate levels of radon of the House
- to below 4 pCi/L within sixty (60) days from enactment of
- 19 this Act.
- 20 (1) The House shall receive the nomination of the
- 21 company chosen and cost to mitigate and vote on
- 22 adoption of the company and cost, which shall not
- exceed § 3 of this Act.
- 24 (2) Unless the company is exempt as described in
- subsection (c), they shall be subject to HCC § 2-7-1.

26 27	(b) DEADLINE.—This action must be fulfilled by July 30, 2024.
28 29 30	(c) EXEMPTIONS.—If the House appoints any of the following mitigators as described in subsection (a), they shall be exempt from HCC § 2-7-1:
31 32	(1) A+ Radon Solutions Inc., located in Valparaiso, Indiana; and
33 34	(2) SWAT Environmental, located in South Bend, Indiana.
35	SECTION 5. Annual reporting.
36 37	The Sergeant-at-Arms shall report to the House annually the level of radon in the House.
38	(1) This section shall take effect in January 2025.
