## A BILL TO

Allow the prohibition of certain individuals to be on the property of the House.

**E IT ENACTED** by this House of Commons with the advice and consent of the same, as follows:

#### 1 SECTION 1. Title.

- 2 This bill may be cited as the "Prohibition of Certain
- 3 Individuals Act."

#### 4 SECTION 2. Prohibition.

- 5 (a) GENERALLY.—Individuals who either:
- 6 (1) pose a risk to the House or its Members; or
- 7 (2) are not desired on House property wherein the
- 8 Speaker believes it is in the interest of Members;
- 9 shall be prohibited from being on House property.
- 10 (b) EXEMPTION.—Individuals acting in their capacity as
- 11 an official of the government or as part of an agreement
- 12 between the party and the House shall not be subject to
- 13 this Act.
- 14 (c) POWER TO DECLARE.—The Speaker shall have the
- 15 sole power to declare all individuals who are prohibited on
- 16 House property by declaration.
- 17 (d) DISAPPROVAL.—All declarations as described in
- 18 subsection (c) shall be treated as a rule that can be
- 19 disapproved under HCC § 2-14-4.

#### 20 SECTION 3. Enforcement.

The Sergeant-at-Arms shall enforce all declarations ofprohibition.

#### 23 **SECTION 4. Violations.**

- 24 People who are on House property who have been
- 25 classified as prohibited and those who assist a prohibited
- 26 person from being on House property shall have

- 27 committed a Class B Felony as described under HCC § 2-
- 28 2-4(a)(3).
