Permit the Department of Revenue to reimburse Members of the House for related House expenses.

E IT ENACTED by this House of Commons with the advice and consent of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Title.
- 2 This Act may be cited as the "House Reimbursement Act."
- 3 SECTION 2. Reimbursement.
- 4 (a) GENERALLY.—Any Member of the House may
- 5 submit to the Secretary of the Department of Revenue a
- 6 request for reimbursement of an expense that is one that
- 7 is related to the operations of the House.
- 8 (b) PRIOR APPROVAL.—A person who seeks to be
- 9 reimbursement must seek approval prior to the expense
- 10 from an Agency Head, the Clerk of the House, or the
- 11 Speaker of the House.
- 12 (c) LIMITS.—A person may not be reimbursed more than
- 13 fifty (50) dollars in one calendar year without the consent
- of the House Assembly and the Speaker.
- 15 (d) SALARY REGULATIONS.—Any and all regulations
- and laws regulating salary payments shall not be subject
- 17 to this Act.
- 18 (e) ADMINISTRATIVE AUTHORITY.—The Secretary of
- 19 the Department of Revenue shall have the authority to
- 20 issue administrative code with respect to this act as
- 21 necessary under HCC § 2-14-1 et seq.
