SPECIAL ORDERS

SPEECHES

The Chair may recognize Members for special-order speeches for up to four hours. Such speeches may not extend beyond the 4-hour limit without the permission of the Chair, which may be granted only with advance consultation between the Speaker and notification to the House. However, the Chair will not recognize for any special-order speeches beyond 10 o'clock in the evening.

The format for recognition by the Speaker is without prejudice to the Speaker's ultimate power of recognition under the Rules of the House and includes the ability to withdraw recognition for longer special-order speeches should circumstances warrant.

SPECIAL LEGISLATIVE DAYS

Calendar Wednesday

Wednesday of each week, when specifically noticed, except during the last 2 weeks of a session. Mondays of each month.

On Wednesday of each week, business shall be subject to the House Calendar only, except those considered as privileged under the Rules of the House.

Private Calendar

First Tuesdays of each month.

Suspension of Rules

Mondays, Tuesday, and Wednesdays and during the last 6 days of a session.
