DECLARATION OF STATE OF EMERGENCY

DECEMBER 20, 2022

WHEREAS,

The National Weather Service (NWS) is predicting a major winter

weather storm later this week.

WHEREAS,

The heaviest snow accumulations are expected between late

Thursday night through Friday evening.

WHEREAS,

Very windy conditions with wind gusts up to 49 miles per hour are

expected leading to blowing and drifting snows with the possibility

of blizzard like conditions.

WHEREAS,

There will be dangerous wind chills through Saturday with chills

15 to 25 below zero.

WHEREAS,

Models are predicting 8-12 inches of system snow in addition to 6

or more inches of lake effect snow expected to start Saturday.

WHEREAS,

NWS is expected to issue winter weather statements when the

event in closer.

WHEREAS,

House of Commons Code § 2-5-6 gives me the sole power and

authority to declare a State of Emergency when assistance and/or resources are needed to relieve and/or control a situation that

requires abnormal support, resources, and funding.

THEREFORE, BE IT

Resolved,

that a State of Emergency as defined in HCC § 2-5-6 is hereby declared effective at 5:00 PM (CST) on Thursday, December 22, 2022 through 9:00 PM (CST) on Saturday, December 24, 2022 and

may be extended should it be warranted.

Resolved,

that I order the Highway Management Agency (HMA) to spend the

necessary funds to prepare the roads in the House's jurisdiction

and to shovel and treat the road.

Resolved,

that Members are strongly encouraged not to travel outside of the

House while a State of Emergency is in effect.
