- 6 control a situation that requires abnormal support,

- 9 Resolved, that HCC § 2-5-6 have the following clause
- 10 added, as follows:
- 11 "(d) The Speaker shall have more discretion in issuing a
- 12 State of Emergency when the House is not in session."
- 13 Resolved, that HCC § 2-5-7 is amended by inserting the
- 14 following "active":
- "declaration or State of Emergency".
