***Joint* RESOLUTION**

to

amend the State of Emergency.

BE IT ENACTED by this House of Commons, in this present, assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1 *Resolved*, that HCC § 2-5-6(a) be stricken and replaced
2 as follows:

3 “(a) The Speaker of the House shall have the sole power to
4 declare a State of Emergency in the House when
5 assistance and/or resources are needed to relieve and/or
6 control a situation that requires abnormal support,
7 resources, and funding; however, must not relate to
8 damage from the weather.”

9 *Resolved*, that HCC § 2-5-6 have the following clause
10 added, as follows:

11 “(d) The Speaker shall have more discretion in issuing a
12 State of Emergency when the House is not in session.”

13 *Resolved*, that HCC § 2-5-7 is amended by inserting the
14 following “active”:

15 “declaration or State of Emergency”.
