***Joint* RESOLUTION**

to

amend No Excuse Tobacco Act (NETA).

TABLE OF PROVISIONS.

BE IT ENACTED by this House of Commons, in this present, assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1 *Resolved*, that Section 3 of HR 6 (Public Law 221-04) be
2 amended as follows:

3 **“SECTION 3. Failure to follow.**
4 “Failure of any persons to comply with § 2 of this
5 Act is subject to the following classifications:
6 “(i) Class C Misdemeanor if it is the first
7 offense and/or within 25 feet of animals;
8 “(ii) Class D Felony if it is the second offense
9 and/or within 15 feet of animals;
10 “(iii) Class C Felony if it is the third offense
11 and/or within 10 feet of animals; and
12 “(iv) Class B Felony for all subsequent
13 offenses and/or within 3 feet of animals.”

14 *Resolved*, that Sections 4, 5, and 6 of HR 6 (Public Law
15 221-04) be repealed.
