B E IT ENACTED by this House of Commons, in this present, assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1	Resolved, that Section 3 of HR 6 (Public Law 221-04) be

6	"(i) Class C Misdemeanor if it is the first

9	and/or within 15 feet of animals;
10	"(iii) Class C Felony if it is the third offense
10	and/or within 10 feet of animals; and
12	"(iv) Class B Felony for all subsequent
	offenses and/or within 3 feet of animals."
