Amend Rule X of the Rules of the House.

TABLE OF PROVISIONS.

B E IT ENACTED by this House of Commons, in this present, assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

- 1 *Resolved*, that the 2022 Assembly Rules of the House be
2 amended in Rule X (10) in the following spots—
- 3 (i) In Clause 1(b), add “, *being germane*,” in between
4 the words debate and avoiding.
- 5 (ii) Add the following Clauses after 1(b):
- 6 “(c) *A Member may interrupt a Member during debate*
7 *to ask if they yield to a question that is germane. If the*
8 *Member responds in the affirmative, the Member*
9 *having the question will ask the question and the*
10 *Member shall respond in any way they please. If the*
11 *Member responds in the negative, the Member with*
12 *the question does not have the right to ask the*
13 *question and the Member under recognition may*
14 *resume talking. The Member under original*
15 *recognition for set period of time claims the time.*
- 16 (d) *Subsection (c) shall not apply to—*
- 17 (i) *speeches or motions; and*
- 18 (ii) *parliamentary inquiries.*
- 19 (e) *Members can interrupt another Member under*
20 *recognition for certain motions as granted under The*
21 *Rules of the House.”*
