TABLE OF PROVISIONS.

B E IT ENACTED by this House of Commons, in this present, assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1 2	Resolved, that the 2022 Assembly Rules of the House be amended in Rule X (10) in the following spots—
3 4	(i) In Clause 1(b), add ", being germane," in between the words debate and avoiding.
5	(ii) Add the following Clauses after 1(b):
6 7 8 9 .0 .1 .2 .3 .4	"(c) A Member may interrupt a Member during debate to ask if they yield to a question that is germane. If the Member responds in the affirmative, the Member having the question will ask the question and the Member shall respond in any way they please. If the Member responds in the negative, the Member with the question does not have the right to ask the question and the Member under recognition may resume talking. The Member under original recognition for set period of time claims the time.
.6	(d) Subsection (c) shall not apply to—
.7	(i) speeches or motions; and
.8	(ii) parliamentary inquiries.
.9 20 21	(e) Members can interrupt another Member under recognition for certain motions as granted under The Rules of the House."
