RESOLUTION

to

provide for the consideration of the bill, HR 9,
Amendment to the House Renovation Act of 2021.

TABLE OF PROVISIONS.

BE IT ENACTED by this House of Commons, in this present, assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1 *Resolved*, that at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution (H. Res. 22), the Speaker may, pursuant to
3 Rule XII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
4 of the Whole House for consideration of the bill (HR 9),
5 Amendment to the House Renovation Act of 2021. The
6 first reading of the bill shall be dispensed with. All points
7 of order against consideration of the bill are waived.
8 General debate shall be confined to the bill and shall not
9 exceed one hour equally divided and controlled by a
10 proponent and opponent of the bill, HR 9. After general
11 debate the bill shall be considered for amendment under
12 the five-minute rule. An amendment in the nature of a
13 substitute consisting of the text of Rule Committee Report
14 221-02, modified by the amendment printed in Part A of
15 the Report of the Committee on Rules & Reform
16 accompanying this resolution, shall be considered as
17 adopted in the House and in the Committee of the Whole
18 House. The bill, as amended, shall be considered as the
19 original bill for the purpose of further amendment under
20 the five-minute rule and shall be considered as read. All
21 points of order against provisions in the bill, as amended,
22 are waived. No further amendment to the bill, as
23 amended, shall be in order except those printed in Part B
24 of the Report of the Committee on Rules & Reform. Each
25 further amendment may be offered only in the order
26 printed in the report, may be offered only by a Member
27 designated in the report, shall be considered as read, shall
28 be debatable for the time specified in the report equally
29 divided and controlled by the proponent and an opponent,
30 shall not be subject to amendment, and shall not be
31 subject to a demand for division of the question in the
32 House or in the Committee of the Whole House. All points
33 of order against such further amendments are waived. At
34 the conclusion of consideration of the bill for amendment

35 the Committee shall rise and report the bill, as amended,
36 to the House with such further amendments as may have
37 been adopted. The previous question shall be considered
38 as ordered on the bill, as amended, and any further
39 amendments thereto to final passage without intervening
40 motion except one motion to recommit with or without
41 instructions.
