SECTION 1.           RESOLVED.

---

**B** E IT ENACTED by this House of Commons, in this present, assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1 *Resolved*, that if House Report 221-04 is called up by  
2 direction of the Committee on Vacation:

3 (a) All points of order against the report are waived  
4 and the report shall be considered as read; and

5 (b)(1) an accompanying resolution offered by the  
6 direction of the Committee on Vacation shall be  
7 considered as read and shall not be subject to a  
8 point of order; and

9 (2) the previous question shall be considered as  
10 ordered on such resolution to adoption without  
11 intervening motion or demand for division of the  
12 question except one hour of debate equally divided  
13 and controlled by a proponent and opponent or  
14 their respective designees.
