8 9	(1) One hour of debate divided by a proponent and opponent; and
10	(2) one motion to recommit.
11 12 13 14 15 16 17 18	Resolved, that upon the adoption of this resolution, it shall be in order to consider in the House the bill HR 28, the Outdoor Advancement Act of 2022. All points of order against consideration of the bill are waived. The bill shall be considered as read. All points of order against provisions in the bill, as amended, are waived. The previous question shall be considered as ordered on the bill, and on any further amendment thereto, to final passage without intervening motion, except:
20 21	(1) One hour of debate divided by a proponent and opponent;
22 23	(2) The further amendments described in Section 3 of the resolution; and
24	(3) one motion to recommit.
25 26 27 28 29 30	Resolved, after debate pursuant to Section 2 of this resolution, each further amendment printed in Part B of the report of the Committee on Rules & Reform Text 221-05 not earlier considered shall be considered only in the order printed in the report, may be offered only by a Member designated in the report, shall be considered as

read, shall be debatable for the time specified in the report equally divided and controlled by the proponent and an opponent, may be withdrawn by the proponent at any time before the question is put thereon, shall not be subject to amendment, and shall not be subject to a demand for division of the question.
