BE IT ENACTED by this House of Commons, in this present, assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1 *Resolved*, that upon the adoption of this Resolution, it
2 shall be in order without intervention of any point of
3 order to consider the Resolution (H Res 47), naming the
4 brown duck of the House of Commons. The previous
5 question shall be considered as ordered on the resolution
6 to adoption without intervening motion or demand for
7 division of the question except:

8 (1) One hour of debate divided by a proponent and
9 opponent; and

10 (2) one motion to recommit.

11 *Resolved*, that upon the adoption of this resolution, it
12 shall be in order to consider in the House the bill HR 28,
13 the Outdoor Advancement Act of 2022. All points of order
14 against consideration of the bill are waived. The bill shall
15 be considered as read. All points of order against
16 provisions in the bill, as amended, are waived. The
17 previous question shall be considered as ordered on the
18 bill, and on any further amendment thereto, to final
19 passage without intervening motion, except:

20 (1) One hour of debate divided by a proponent and
21 opponent;

22 (2) The further amendments described in Section 3
23 of the resolution; and

24 (3) one motion to recommit.

25 *Resolved*, after debate pursuant to Section 2 of this
26 resolution, each further amendment printed in Part B of
27 the report of the Committee on Rules & Reform Text 221-
28 05 not earlier considered shall be considered only in the
29 order printed in the report, may be offered only by a
30 Member designated in the report, shall be considered as

31 read, shall be debatable for the time specified in the
32 report equally divided and controlled by the proponent
33 and an opponent, may be withdrawn by the proponent at
34 any time before the question is put thereon, shall not be
35 subject to amendment, and shall not be subject to a
36 demand for division of the question.
