RESOLUTION

to

establish a select committee to investigate House
Renovation practices.

BE IT ENACTED by this House of Commons, in this present, assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1 Whereas, the House passed The House Renovation Act of
 2 2021 and appointed George Neal to serve as the
 3 contractor to complete such tasks.

4 Whereas, George has—

5 (1) failed to abide by the Act and add additional
 6 items not agreed upon;

7 (2) failed to clearly communicate what is necessary
 8 in order to fulfil the Act;

9 (3) ordered materials that are excessive or
 10 inappropriate for the purposes of the Act;

11 (4) failed to listen to directions by the Sergeant-at-
 12 Arms and the Speaker; and

13 (5) damaged certain objects that are property of the
 14 House and has failed to compensate for such
 15 damages.

16 Now, therefore, be it

17 *Resolved*,—

18 **SECTION 1. ESTABLISHMENT.**

19 There is hereby established the Select Committee
 20 to Investigate House Renovation Practices
 21 (hereinafter referred to as the “Select Committee”).

22 **SECTION 2. COMPOSITION.**

23 (a) APPOINTMENT OF MEMBERS.—The Speaker
24 shall appoint 2 Members to the Select Committee.

25 (b) DESIGNATION OF CHAIR.—The Speaker
26 shall designate one Member to serve as the Chair of
27 the Select Committee.

28 (c) VACANCIES.—Any vacancy in the Select
29 Committee shall be filled in the same manner as
30 the original appointment.

31 **SECTION 3. PURPOSES.**

32 The purposes of the Select Committee are the
33 following:

34 (1) To investigate and report upon the facts
35 in respect to all violations of the House
36 Renovation Act (hereinafter referred to as
37 the “Act”).

38 (2) To investigate and report upon the facts
39 in respect to all damage occurring because of
40 George Neal.

41 (3) Pursuant to House Resolution 53, provide
42 for a replacement contractor and approve the
43 dissolution of George Neal as the contractor.

44 **SECTION 4. FUNCTIONS.**

45 (a) The functions of the Select Committee are to—

46 (1) Find all violations of George Neal in
47 respect to the Act.

48 (2) Find all damage to the Property of the
49 House caused by George Neal and an
50 estimated value to replace such damage.

51 (3) Provide for approval of dissolution of
52 George Neal.

53 (4) Provide for a replacement of a contractor
54 to repair and finish all aspects of the Act.

55 (5) Issue a final report to the House
56 containing such findings, conclusions, and

57 recommendations.

58 (b) REPORTS.—In addition to the final report
59 addressing the manners in Section 4(a), the Select
60 Committee may report to the House or any
61 committee of the House from time to time the
62 results of its investigations, together with such
63 detailed findings and legislative recommendations
64 as it may deem advisable.

65 (c) The Select Committee may not hold a markup of
66 legislation.

67 **SECTION 5. TERMINATION AND RECORDS.**

68 (a) TERMINATION.—The Select Committee shall
69 terminate 30 days after filing the final report.

70 (b) RECORDS.—Upon the termination of the Select
71 Committee, the records of the Select Committee
72 shall become records of the House as designated by
73 the Speaker.

Speaker of the House Assent
