BE IT ENACTED by this House of Commons, in this present, assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

- 1 *Resolved*, that the House of Commons hereby finds
2 favorably and permits that the Select Committee to
3 Investigate House Renovation Practices be permitted
4 under law to criminally prosecute and press charges
5 against Mr. George Neal.
- 6 *Resolved*, that the Speaker of the House shall certify the
7 final report of the Select Committee to Investigate House
8 Renovation Practices, detailing the violations of Mr.
9 George Neal, to the Sergeant-at-Arms, to the end that Mr.
10 Neal be proceeded against in the manner and form
11 provided by law.
- 12 *Resolved*, that the Sergeant-at-Arms shall otherwise
13 take all appropriate action to enforce this Resolution.
