BE IT ENACTED by this House of Commons, in this present, assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1 *Resolved*, that upon the adoption of this resolution it
2 shall be in order to consider in the House the bill, HR 38,
3 The Taxation Act. All points of order against
4 consideration of the bill are waived. All points of order
5 against provisions in the bill are waived. The previous
6 question shall be considered as ordered on the bill thereto
7 final passage without intervening motion except: (1) hour
8 of debate equally divided and controlled by a proponent
9 and opponent and (2) one motion to recommit.

10 *Resolved*, that upon the adoption of this resolution it
11 shall be in order to consider in the House the Joint
12 Resolution, H J Res 16, a Joint Resolution to establish
13 and ratify the first Constitution of the House of Commons.
14 All points of order against consideration of the joint
15 resolution are waived. All points of order against
16 provisions in the joint resolution are waived. The previous
17 question shall be considered as ordered on the joint
18 resolution thereto final passage without intervening
19 motion except: (1) hour of debate equally divided and
20 controlled by a proponent and opponent and (2) one
21 motion to recommit.
