BE IT ENACTED by this House of Commons, in this present, assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

- 1 WHEREAS, Tim Cavinder was issued a ticket on October
2 22, 2022 (No. 222-09) for \$35 for violating HCC 10-4-1(a),
3 which states “It shall be unlawful for anyone to display a
4 political or messaging sign on the property of the House
5 without the concurrence of the House.”
- 6 WHEREAS, Tim Cavinder placed a sign, and still
7 remains, displaying a messaging sign in respect to an
8 effort to make a Bypass in La Porte County saying that
9 “La Porte County says no”.
- 10 WHEREAS, The Speaker provided Tim Cavinder a
11 warning letter asking the sign to be removed or ask the
12 House for consent as required under statue.
- 13 WHEREAS, Tim Cavinder failed to remove the sign nor
14 ask for consent and was issued a ticket under a Class C
15 Misdemeanor.
- 16 WHEREAS, As granted under HCC 2-1-5, Tim Cavinder
17 appealed his fine. However, his demand to appeal was
18 incomplete and in violation of HCC 2-1-5(a) as the appeal
19 was beyond the ten (10) day requirement.
- 20 WHEREAS, The Speaker (as required under HCC 2-1-
21 5(e)) declared that the fine remain standing pursuant to
22 the reasoning described above.
- 23 *Resolved*, that as provided under HCC 2-1-6(c)(3), Tim
24 Cavinder seeks, with the concurrence of the House, the
25 forgiveness of Ticket No. 222-09 and the \$35 fine.
