B IT ENACTED by this House of Commons, in this present, assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

- 1 SECTION 1. Title.
- 2 (a) This Act shall be cited as "Speaker Succession Act".
- 3 **SECTION 2. Speaker's death or resignation.**
- 4 (a) SUPERSEED.—This Act shall supersede any Rules of
- 5 the House as applicable.
- 6 (b) Upon the death or resignation of the Speaker, the7 following line of succession shall be used:
- 8 (i) Clerk of the House;
- 9 (ii) Sergeant-at-Arms;
- 10 (iii) Chief Administrative Officer.
- 11 (c) Within thirty (30) days from death or resignation of
- 12 the Speaker, the House shall hold a new election for the
- 13 Speaker of the House.
